

PSCRB-Revalidation (Officer)

Course Overview

This course aims to provide the training for candidates to launch and take charge of a survival craft or rescue boat in emergency situations, in accordance with Section A-VII/2 of the STCW Code.

This course covers the requirements of the 1978 STCW Convention, as amended, Chapter VI, Section AVI/2, and Table A-VI/2-1. On meeting the minimum standard of competence in survival craft and rescue boats other than fast rescue boats, a trainee will be competent to:

- Operate life-saving appliances •
- Take charge of a survival craft or rescue boat during or • after launch.
- Operate a survival craft engine and manage survivors • and survival craft after abandoning ship.
- Explain the correct use of all locating devices, including communication and signaling apparatus and pyrotechnics,
- Apply first aid to survivors •
- Describe and perform actions to preserve the lives of • those in their charge.

Survival techniques(theory)

- Manage survivors and survival craft after abandoning ship Demonstrating of locating devices, including communication and signaling apparatus and **Pvrotechnics**
- Operation of survival craft engine •
- Demonstration of on-load / off-load release device •
- Take charge of a survival craft •
- Launching and recovery of lifeboat/rescue boat
- Take charge of launching in rough sea
